Mrs. Jean Kathryn Byrd Taylor, 67, died November 18, 2016. Funeral services will be held 2:00 p.m. November 20, at Bethlehem United Methodist Church with graveside following at Magnolia Cemetery directed by Brown-Pennington-Atkins. The family will receive friends Saturday from 4:00 to 6:00 p.m. at the funeral home. In lieu of flowers, memorials may be made in her honor to the Darlington County School District for the Children of St. John's Elementary School.

Born in Leavensworth, SC, she was the youngest of six daughters of the late Marion L. and Mary G. Byrd. She is a graduate of St. John's High, she earned a Bachelor of Arts from Columbia College in 1971 and a Masters in Elementary Education from Francis Marion University. She has been employed by the Darlington County School District since 1973, most recently as the principal of St. John's Elementary, a role that she has cherished for the past 25 years as it allowed her to mentor tens of thousands of children, their parents, staff, friends and the community.

She was an active member of the Darlington Rotary Club, the Delta Kappa Gamma Education Sorority and was honored with the Darlington County Educator Award in 2006, and the Darlington County School District Distinguished Principal's Award for the 2011 - 2012 school year.

She met her husband, Lee, in Hartsville and they were married in 1971. She was a lifelong active member of Bethlehem United Methodist Church serving in countless roles for her church family. She bravely faced cancer three times in her life, and although the disease weakened her body, her spirit and faith were always unwavering.

Surviving are her loving husband of 45 years, H. Lee Taylor of Darlington; three daughters, Reagan Taylor Luley (Rob) of Fort Mill; Kristen Taylor Nicholson (Herb) of Hartsville; Keri Jacquelin Taylor of Darlington; three grandchildren, Marcos Robert Luley of Fort Mill, and Mary Claire Nicholson and William Harry "Hank" Nicholson of Hartsville.
