It is with deep sorrow that Mr. Cecil W. "Bill" Watkins, Jr. announces the death of his beloved mother, Mrs. Jean Shirley Watkins, 78.

Mrs. Watkins entered into rest on Friday, January 20, 2023. The Directors of Hancock-Elmore-Hill Funeral Home are caring for the family.

A funeral service to honor her life will be held at 2 o'clock on Tuesday, January 24, 2023, at Hebron United Methodist Church. The Rev. Jerry McManus will officiate with burial to follow in the church cemetery. The family will receive friends in the Church Fellowship Hall immediately following the service.

Jean participated in several pageants in her youth and was Miss Bishopville in the Miss South Carolina pageant and Miss Tobacco Festival Queen in Lake City. After graduating from Bishopville High School, she attended Limestone College in Gaffney, SC, where she was named Miss Limestone. She finished her degree in education after only 3 years. She was married for 29 years and taught school for 39 years. She loved her family, students, and friends dearly. She was loyal until the end and

would do anything to help anyone including strangers. She loved her church, riding roller coasters, throwing parties, playing cards, and most of all, she loved to sing. She will always be remembered by everyone for her Patsy Cline performances. She would take her music machine around and perform at various events. Her memory began to fade over the last few years as her disease progressed, but she never forgot the hymns that she faithfully sang her entire life. Most importantly she never forgot her Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

She is survived by her loving son, Cecil W. "Bill" (Susan) Watkins, Jr. of Bishopville, SC; grandchildren, Anderson Watkins, and Payne Watkins.
