



Mrs. Joan Snoddy Hoffmeyer

It is with deep sorrow that the Hoffmeyer family announces the passing of their beloved mother, Mrs. Joan Snoddy Hoffmeyer, 94.

Mrs. Hoffmeyer, the widow of Gus Hoffmeyer, Jr., entered into rest on Saturday, May 31, 2025. The Directors of Brown-Pennington-Atkins Funeral Home & Crematory are caring for the family.

A funeral service to honor her life will be held at 2:00 o'clock on Thursday, June 5, 2025, at Wesley United Methodist Church in Hartsville with Rev. Fred McDaniel officiating. 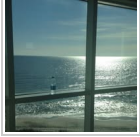
