Mr. Draper died Saturday, January 12, 2008. Born in Kalamazoo, MI, he was a son of the late Warren Carroll and Margaret Southfield Draper. He was a past member of Rotary and past chairman of the Board of Trustees for Florence-Darlington Technical College.
