



Juanita Pate Shultman

May 11, 1920 - February 7, 2008

Juanita Pate Shultman, 87, of Charlotte, NC, and Garden City Beach, SC, died on February 7, 2008, at Grand Strand Regional Medical Center after a brief illness. Mrs. Shultman, widow of Simon Leroy Shultman, Jr., was born in Kershaw County, SC, on May 11, 1920. She was the daughter of the late Clarence Cleveland Pate and Birdie Yarbrough Pate. She graduated from Bethune High School and Limestone College (class of 1941). Juanita served in the US Navy during World War II. She met "Sy" Shultman while they were both stationed in Oakland, CA, during the war, and they married in Oakland on September 14, 1945. Mrs. Shultman taught in the Spartanburg, SC, public schools before joining the Navy, and afterward in the Horry County and Georgetown, SC, public schools. She later worked with the Mecklenburg County, NC, Department of Social Services until her retirement.

Surviving are her five children and their spouses: Audrey S. McGregor (Buck) and Nancy S. Clark (Bob) of Hillsborough, NC, Marie S. Young of Garden City Beach, Simon Leroy Shultman III (Debbie), of Charlotte, and Clarence Rhett Shultman (Debbie) of Wytheville, VA; five grandchildren: Richard and Robert McGregor, Elliot and Caroline Clark, and Billy Shultman; niece Rhonda Kay Pate, and nephew Brett Charles Pate. Juanita was predeceased by her brothers Troy G. Pate and Charles H. (Corkey) Pate.

A private graveside service will be held at 2:00 p.m. Sunday, February 10, 2008 at McBee Cemetery, McBee, SC. Brown-Pennington-Atkins Funeral Home, Hartsville, SC, is in charge of arrangements. In lieu of flowers, the
