



Mr. Julius "Tots" Skinner

September 18, 1927 - April 9, 2013

Funeral services for Julius "Tots" Skinner, 85, will be held at 2:30 p.m. Saturday, April 13, 2013 at Hebron United Methodist Church. The Rev. Christine Wechsler will officiate with burial in the church cemetery. The family will receive friends Saturday from 1:30-2:30 p.m. at the church. Brown-Pennington-Atkins Funeral Home is serving the Skinner family.

Mr. Skinner died peacefully on Tuesday, April 9, 2013. Born in Lee Co., SC, he was a son of the late Fred and Evelyn Smith Skinner. He was a member of Hebron United Methodist Church where he played the organ, taught the Adult Sunday School class, and served on the Administrative Board. He served in the U. S. Army during the Korean Conflict and retired from the National Guard. Mr. Skinner was a graduate of the University of South Carolina and retired from DuPont after 38 years of service. He was a member and secretary of the Patesville Masonic Lodge # 295.

Surviving are his sister-in-law, Paulette Skinner of Hartsville, SC; nephews, Tommy Skinner, Robin (Denise) Skinner, Fred (Amy) Skinner, all of Hartsville, SC; nieces, June (Mark Vinson) Skinner of Columbia, SC, Tammie Moore of Lydia, SC, Ellen Blackwell of Hartsville, SC.
