It is with deep sorrow that the Snead family announces the death of their beloved mother, Mrs. June Wright Snead, 92.

Mrs. Snead, the widow of Edgar H. Snead, entered into rest on Sunday, September 22, 2024. The Directors of Hancock-Elmore-Hill Funeral Home are caring for the family.

In the latter portion of her career, she

taught at Robert E. Lee Academy, where she also worked as a librarian in the years just before her retirement.

She was an active member of her community, serving the American Legion Auxillary, Hebron Presbyterian Church, and Woodmen of the World as President and Treasurer for many years. Always thinking of others, she spent much of her time taking care of friends and family.

She leaves behind a daughter, Rebecca Stoudenmire (Special friend, Alan Jordan) of Bishopville, SC; son, Michael Edgar Snead (Bonnie) of Wesley Chapel, NC; grandchildren, Rachel Stoudenmire, Scott Snead (Nicole), Jessie Grapes (Jared), Matt Snead (Jordan), and Davis Snead (Fiance', Haley); great-grandchildren, Olivia June Grapes, John Snead, and Lawson Grapes.
