Kemp "Swami" Charles Nash Jr., 82, passed away Thursday, April 4, 2024, at his home, surrounded by his loving family.

He was born August 22, 1941, in Sumter, SC, the son of the late Kemp Charles Nash Sr. and the late Beulah Snyder Nash. Swami moved to Myrtle Beach in 1973 and opened Coastal Carolina Properties, which became Century 21 in 1978, where he was involved in his community. He was a member of Ocean View Baptist Church, where he was a member of the Men of the Cross group.

Swami was an avid Gamecock fan who graduated from the University of South Carolina in 1964. He was a member of Kappa Sigma fraternity and played on the tennis team. He served his country in the South Carolina Air National Guard.
