



Kent Hungerpiller, Sr.

February 13, 1915 - September 16, 2008

Funeral services for Kent Hungerpiller, Sr., 93, will be held at 5:00 p.m. Friday, September 19, 2008 at First Baptist Church Chapel. The Rev. Ryan Goodroe will officiate with private family burial in First Baptist Church Cemetery. Brown-Pennington-Atkins Funeral Home is serving the family. The family will receive friends Thursday, September 18, 2008 from 5-7 p.m. at the residence, 516 Segars Mill Road, Hartsville, SC. Mr. Hungerpiller died Tuesday, September 16, 2008. Born in Lykesland, SC, he was a son of the late John and Leland Segars Hungerpiller. He was a graduate of Hartsville High School, attended the University of South Carolina, and in World War II, served as Chief Petty Officer in the United States Navy. After the war, he was founder and owner of Kentco Heating and Cooling in Hartsville until his retirement in 1995. He served as past president of the South Carolina Mechanical Contractor's Association.

Mr. Hungerpiller was a charter member of the Hartsville Kiwanis Club, past president of Big Brothers, a founder and past president of the Red Fox Club and also of the Associated Club of Darlington County. He served First Baptist Church as deacon and Sunday school teacher.

Surviving are his wife, Anna Bess Ethridge Hungerpiller of Hartsville, SC; sons and daughters-in-law, Kent and Jean Hungerpiller, Jr. of Myrtle Beach, SC, Colin and Elaine Hungerpiller of Hartsville, SC, David and Stephanie

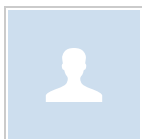
