Funeral services for Larry Dean Burgess, 62, will be held at 11:00 a.m. Friday, August 31, 2007 at the Brown-Pennington-Atkins Funeral Home Chapel. The Rev. Jeff Gardner will officiate with burial in Westview Memorial Park Cemetery. The family will receive friends Thursday, August 30, 2007 from 6-8 p.m. at the funeral home. Mr. Burgess died Tuesday, August 28, 2007. Born in Stephens, Co. GA, he was a son of Flossie Ola McClain and the late Raymond Dean Burgess. He was a graduate of Stephens County High School where he lettered in football as a defensive lineman. He was also a graduate of North Georgia Military College in Dahlonega, GA with a B.S. in Psychology and was a member of Rho Epsilon Xi military fraternity. He was a veteran of the U.S. Air Force having served between 1966 – 1970 with duty stations in Guam, Taiwan and the continental U. S. He received an honorable discharge with the rank of Sgt. His job history included positions as shift manager, department manager and consultant with SANGAMO Electric, Milliken and Co., Galey and Lord, Burlington Industries, U.S. Dept. of Agriculture, and Coca-Cola Inc. until 2004 when he became disabled.

Mr. Burgess was an avid reader that enjoyed hunting, fishing, the outdoors and his two grandsons. He was a caring son and brother, a committed husband, a loving father and grandfather, and a loyal friend.

daughter-in-law, Bradley Dean and Christy Burgess of Hartsville, SC;
daughter and son-in-law, Lori and Kirk Dudley of Elgin, SC; mother of Toccoa,

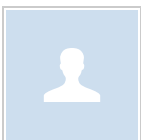
