LeGrand Richard Petty was born December 02, 1956 in Columbia, SC to James Petty and his wife Nina (nee' Wynn). He passed away Saturday, November 09, 2019 in Washington, MO at the age of 62 years.

LeGrand received his education in Hartsville, SC and graduated from Hartsville High School. He continued his education at Brigham Young University and completed a Bachelor of Arts degree in marketing at Webster University. Mr. Petty was sealed in marriage to Lora Street on August 24, 1979, at The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints Washington D.C. Temple. The couple made their home in Provo, UT. They later moved to Conway, SC in 1981, St. Louis, MO in 1984 and then settled in Washington, MO in 2001. LeGrand was employed as a courier with Federal Express for many years and then enjoyed a successful business management career in retail.
