Mr. Furr, widower of Muriel deLawyer Furr, died Saturday, October 23, 2004. Born in Wake Co., NC, he was a son of the late Lemuel H. and Bertha Blackley Furr. He came to Hartsville in 1937 and had several business interests before retirement from Williams Leasing Co. in 1977. He retained his association with S. C. Federal Saving Bank for 25 years. He was a member of the First Baptist Church and the Fellowship Sunday School class. He previously served as president of Hartsville Merchants Assoc., director of the Hartsville Chamber of Commerce, president of Prestwood County Club, and city councilman for three terms. He helped organize the Rescue Squad and was a trustee for 20 years. He was past president of the Civitans and was twice named Civitan of the Year.

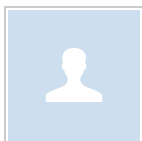
