



Mr. Leo Harold "Billy" Burch

April 23, 1926 - June 3, 2015

Funeral services for Leo Harold "Billy" Burch, 89, will be held at 2:00 pm Monday, June 8, 2015 at Wesley United Methodist Church.

The Rev. Dewey Dean will officiate with burial in Bethel United Methodist Church Cemetery with Masonic rites. The family will receive friends from 4:00 pm - 6:00 pm on Sunday at Brown-Pennington-Atkins Funeral Home.

Mr. Burch passed away peacefully on Wednesday, June 3, 2015 in Jacksonville, FL with his beloved pet "Cassie" by his side. Born in Chesterfield County, SC, he was a son of the late Leo Harold and Mary Etta Sutton Burch. He was a lifetime resident of Hartsville, SC, but spent his final years in Jacksonville. He was a member of Wesley United Methodist Church and the Hartsville Masonic Lodge #173.

Billy served in the United States Navy during WWII. He worked at Sonoco for 45 years and returned after retirement to work in the mail room. He also worked for the Darlington County Voter Registration & Elections.
