At the age of 16 he joined the South Carolina National Guard. later serving in the Air Force and then the Army in the 10th Air Transport Brigade, 11th Air Assault Division, Company A. He retired from civil service after 30 years of service.

Leon was an entrepreneur, owning three businesses throughout his life. After retiring he worked in finance and sales.

He loved animals, helping others in need, was soft hearted and mentored many during his life. A superb mechanic and carpenter, he often volunteered his time for church projects. Leon was meticulous in all tasks. He was a man of few words but always quick-witted with a joke.

Leon is survived by his loving wife Dina Ekis Hart of Hartsville, SC; daughters, Terri Hart King (Richard) of Hartsville, SC, Donna Hart Starling (Joe) of Hartsville, SC, and Karen Hart Blankenship (Brandon) of Florence, SC; nine grandchildren; 16 great-grandchildren; a special niece, Burney Bristow Byrd (Jerry) of Hartsville, SC.

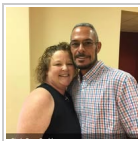
