Funeral services for Mrs. Lilyanne Peterkin Inabinet, 84, who died peacefully on Saturday, May 12, 2018 will be conducted at Magnolia Cemetery at 11:00 a.m. on Wednesday, May 16, 2018. Visitation will precede the service at St. Luke Methodist Church from 10:00 - 10:45 a.m. The Reverend Carl Hunsucker will officiate. Lilyanne was born March 31, 1934 in Ft. Motte, SC. She was the daughter of John Alexander Peterkin and Florence Shuler Peterkin Owings. Lilyanne's husband of 58 years, David Allen Inabinet, was the son of Jimmie Franklin Inabinet and Lillie Wannamaker of St. Matthews. Lilyanne graduated in 1955 from the Medical College of SC and Roper Hospital School of Nursing. After serving as 3rd shift supervisor at the original Byerly Hospital, she went to teach the Licensed Practical Nursing course at the Hartsville Vocational School. Her students learned nursing from the best; in all the 25 years she taught, every student who graduated from her course passed their State Board of Nursing Licensure Exam. After retiring, David and Lilyanne moved to Lake Robinson, where they entertained friends and family at their beautiful lakeside home. She was an avid reader and loved to travel the world with a group of friends affectionately called the Pizza Group. She also dedicated her

retirement time volunteering for the American Red Cross, teaching Sunday School and working with the local food bank.

Lilyanne is preceded in death by both parents, husband David, sister Florence Shuler Knapp, and nephews Robert K. Bass, Jr. and the boys, Johnny and Grant Knapp.

Lilyanne is survived by her children Ellen Kae Dawkins (Bill) of Greensboro, NC, Susan Owings Inabinet of Huntersville, NC and Bill Inabinet of Columbia, SC. She has three grandchildren, Katherine Lea, Thomas Nathan and Jordan Day, and two great-grandchildren, William Daniel and Christopher Owen and nieces Elizabeth W. Bass (Beth) of Atlanta, Ga., Donna Lynn Love of Columbia, Lucy Frohn (Clay) of Charlotte and Maureen (Carlos) Vasquez of Indiana and other beloved family members.

SO many fond memories from Girl Scouts and from my LPN Training will always hold a special place in my heart. She was a special lady and all her students loved her (once we graduated and passed boards) It didn't take long to realize she was tough because she produced the BEST NURSES in Darlington county. I had the pleasure of caring for her as a patient and she chuckled and said "Valerie, I must have done something right, You are a wonderful nurse, Your skills are impeccable" We both laughed as I told her "I am no longer intimidated by Mr. Lilyanne Inabinet as I was in the early 1980's. I thought I was done the day I passed out on the floor while Dr Pickens Moyd and Tona Tedder and I the student nurse were placing a chest tube in a patient and it was my first. Tona sat me outside the room and they continued the procedure. I woke up with your Mother standing over me with this stern Lilyanne look, arms crossed and she said "Valerie, NEVER leave your patient during a procedure" "I stood up, staggered and said "Yes Ma'am but..." She said "No excuses, Never leave your patient during a procedure" She said gather your things and go home, we will talk about it tomorrow. I cried all night thinking I was out of the program. She never mentioned it again until after graduation. She came to me and said, "Valerie, the day you passed out in clinicals made you a better nurse. I gave you something to think about" That she did! She was such a wonderful role model in so many ways. She certainly must have trained 90% of the LPNs in the county in the 1970's until she retired. Many of us went on to become RN's because of her influence and our passion for nursing. I will always owe her a debt of gratitude. Praying for you and your family.

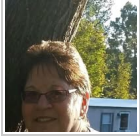
