



Mr. Lloyd Fritz Morrison

Graveside services for Lloyd Fritz Morrison, 89, will be held at 2:00 pm Sunday, May 28, 2017 at Prospect United Methodist Church Cemetery. The Rev. John Bolin will officiate and the family will receive friends following the service in the Fellowship Hall. Brown-Pennington-Atkins is serving the family. Mr. Morrison died Thursday, May 25, 2017. Born in Chesterfield County, SC, he was a son of the late Edward Preston and Bessie Alene Hall Morrison.

He graduated from Spartanburg Methodist College and the University of South Carolina. He was a member of Prospect United Methodist Church and served in the U. S. Navy for four years. Fritz spent most of his life helping his father and later his brothers run the family farm. Fritz, Brooks and Gene had a compatible work relationship as they shared the farm work and activities as it progressed from growing cotton to pine trees. Many special times were when family and friends gathered at the Lake Robinson for food and skiing.

Fritz was known by his close friends and family for his comical and exaggerated tales of his deer hunts, deep sea fishing trips, bird shoots and other tall tales. His most animated comments were when U.S.C. and Clemson opposed each other in athletics.

Fritz especially enjoyed times spent with Randy Morrison, Edd Perdue and Daryl Bullis. His hobbies were hunting, fishing, farm and building projects and

just "hanging out" with these devoted and special people in his life. As we say our good-byes, Fritz would say to us his usual "tootle-do." All is well.

Surviving are his sister, Willene Gardner of Rock Hill, SC; brothers, Robert Brooks Morrison of Hartsville, SC and Bruce Horner Morrison of Charlotte, NC. He leaves several much admired and loved nieces and nephews and their spouses. He was preceded in death by his brothers, Dr. Milton Leroy Morrison, Edward Harold Morrison, Howard Eugene Morrison; sister, Betty Morrison Lysz.
