Louise was a registered nurse and a graduate of the McLeod Infirmary Nursing School in Florence SC, which she attended during World War II as a member of the Cadet Nurse Corps. After graduation, she worked at McLeod Infirmary and other hospitals around the state. She retired from South Carolina DHEC. She and Tilden later moved to the Bethea Baptist Retirement Community in Darlington and was a member of Mt. Elon Baptist Church in Lydia.
