Louise Wilson Sturdivant entered peacefully into eternal rest on Monday, November 1, 2021, at the age of 99. She was born on September 16, 1922, to the late Greenwood and Estelle Carter Wilson. She was preceded in death by her husband, John Edward Sturdivant, Jr., and a sister, Frances Dutton.

She was a member of The First Baptist Church of Florence in her younger years and in later years, the Gospel Temple.
