June 1, 1933 - May 14, 2010

Funeral services for McKinnon Hopkins "Mack" Webb, 76, will be held at 3:00 p.m. Sunday, May 16, 2010 at Brown-Pennington-Atkins Funeral Home Chapel. The Rev. Dr. Gary Colboch will officiate with burial in Westview Memorial Park Cemetery. The family will receive friends Saturday, May 15, 2010 from 5-7 p.m. at the funeral home. Mr. Webb, widower of his wife of 57 years, Elizabeth Goodson Webb, died Friday, May 14, 2010. Born in Darlington Co., SC, he was a son of the late William Rufus and Mattie Kissiah Webb. He was known by many in the community as "Mr. Christmas" because of his Christmas light display that he put up for 30 years on Swift Creek Road. He was a second generation carpenter and fireman, and a volunteer fireman for 35 years with the Hartsville Fire Department.
