



Mrs. Mae Breeden Proctor

January 29, 1908 - July 27, 2015

Mae Breeden Proctor, 107, passed away on July 27, 2015, at Brookdale Skylyn Retirement Center following an extended illness. Born on January 29, 1908, in Clio, SC, she was the daughter of the late James Thomas Breeden and Annie Belle Bundy Breeden.

Mrs. Proctor was predeceased by her husband of 32 years, Edwin Proctor. She was also predeceased by her three brothers and three sisters. Survivors include her son, Dr. James E. Proctor and wife Jane; grandson, Richard Proctor and wife Margaret; grandson, David Proctor and wife, Lynn, all of Spartanburg; great-grandchildren, Abigail, Addison, Hampton, and George.
