Mrs. Gaskins, widow of Robert Lee Gaskins, died peacefully on Wednesday, May 21, 2014, with her family at her bedside. Born in Malden, MA, she was a daughter of the late William and Ida Howard Werre, of Stoneham, MA.

She was a graduate of Stoneham High School, Stoneham, MA and Malden Commercial School. After marrying her beloved Robert and moving to Chesterfield in 1947, Marjorie began her career as Administrative Assistant to the Superintendent of Education for the Chesterfield County School District. She was a dedicated employee for 36 years and remained an advocate for education as a career.

Upon her retirement, Margie pursued her childhood love of art, becoming well-known in the community for her oil paintings of local landmarks and residential homes. She was also instrumental in the development of the Chesterfield Visual Arts Alliance, chartered in 1993. Marjorie was a longstanding and faithful member of Chesterfield Baptist Church.
