Funeral services for Mrs. Martha Moye Dickinson Peel will be held at 2:00 pm on Sunday, November 15, 2020, in Wesley United Methodist Church. The Rev. Born in Bamberg, South Carolina, she was the daughter of Hortense and George Dickinson. Martha Moye was a life-long, resident of Hartsville, SC. Martha Moye graduated from Columbia College and the University of South Carolina and was an elementary school teacher early in her career, but most will remember her for her long tenure as Hartsville High School's Librarian, where she had many loved student helpers over the years. After her retirement, she enjoyed tennis, her second home, in Lands End, in the South Carolina Lowcountry, and participation in many clubs and associations.

She was a life-long member of Wesley United Methodist Church and loved being in the choir, as well as the Thursday Study Club. She always enjoyed

the social interaction and competition that came from her bridge club. A Master Gardener, she was a member of the Pine and Lake Garden Club. She enjoyed traveling, and always looked forward to her next trip to Europe. She was also a member of the Daughters of the American Revolution. She enjoyed her time with her friends, and they will remember her for her wit and optimism.

Martha Moyer is survived by her husband Chandler Peel, her brother George Dickinson, sons Wesley (Julie) Peel, Jonathan (Emily) Peel, grandchildren Chandler II, Caroline, Luke, John, Turner, and Sam; and many nieces, nephews, and cousins.

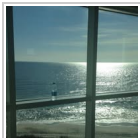

As a result, I was able to finally forgive myself for all of the horrors and pain my active addiction caused others, and myself. My salvation is secure, thanks largely to these people for helping me get there. I cannot begin to tell you how grateful I am for the "Martha Moyer Peels" in my life.

Martha Moyer was a humble servant of God, who truly cared about everyone. We need more of these types of "ministers" around the

country and world, that I know. I hope all of you have a minister and a friend like Anne out there. Fortunately for me, I have several such people in my life....it takes a village for me!

If I thanked a handful of people for helping get me to today, and some I no longer can personally, every day for the rest of my life, it still would never be enough. I could not do anything but mess my life up. The strong will and determination of a handful of good people (along with my mom and dad), helped my out of the miry pit I was stuck in. Several more helped here and there, but MM was consistent. She dug in, and stayed "dug in." Like the Good Samaritan in the parable in the gospel of Luke, she hung in there with me, when many fled. It sure was not easy to stay!

To the family and loved ones of Martha Moye, may God comfort you all. To all of you out there, you just never know what your CONSISTENT kindness can do for a person that wants to die. I was that person.

Today, I give back and pay it forward daily, as I serve the Lord Jesus in various ways. I am so very grateful I knew her.
