“ Mama,

Just wanted to let you know how much I love you and miss you. Wish I could go back to the days that we stayed home and you could sit in your chair and write your music, before you got to where you didn't feel like doing any of it. Wish you could see Cody, how pretty he is and how he has grown. He still remembers that you were in the bedroom - sometimes he looks at the door like he wants to go in - I keep it shut all the time. I asked him the other day where was NaNa's room and he pointed to the door and smiled. Melanie is going to have a little girl in April. I do wish you could be here. Rebecca, Van, and I went to Florida a couple of weeks before Christmas to see Lolo. I couldn't think of anything but that you should have been going to see her instead of us - all those years that went by that ya'll didn't see each other and you would have enjoyed it so much. It has probably been almost 12 years since you and Melanie and I went. She still looked the same - her hair wasn't even completely gray - and it looked a little wavy. She sounded like her old self when she talked, but she was very frail and didn't feel like talking very much. Her hearing wasn't good, her eyesight similar to yours, and she has to have help getting around. But they said she had a good appetite. Becky said her overall health is really very good. We didn't stay even two hours, I don't believe, because they were fixing supper not long after we got there. She hugged Van and Rebecca and me and told me she loved me. I felt just like you had returned - she was so much like you.

We had supper with Becky the night we went to see Lolo and she came to our hotel the next night because Rebecca had felt bad all day. David and his wife Bobbi had been to see Becky and Lolo a few days before we went. Lolo said her children were good to her. Becky, David and Bobbi came to your visitation and funeral. You would like Bobbi. We felt like we had always known her. I told them that I wished that they could have come to see you before that, because it would have meant so much to you to see them. Debbie wanted to come, too, but she couldn't make flight connections to make it here on time.

Your funeral was just as elegant as Caroline's, only in a different

way. They say not many people attend an older person's funeral, but you were an exception. There was a large crowd for the terribly cold weather. The preachers did a very good job. DeVere said you had said that he could say anything that he wanted to about you, good or bad. It was all very good. And Carolyn's voice was beautiful when she sang "Surely the Presence." You had so many beautiful flowers and Mitchell Dampier did an outstanding job on your casket spray of 86 yellow roses. And Suzanne did an excellent job of taking care of all the sprays and baskets in the very cold weather. I bet yours stayed pretty longer than anyone's ever have.

I've been taking Ben and Glenn to Sunday School and Matthew and Andrew. One Sunday I carried all four of them to Sunday School and to church by myself. We haven't done that again, but we are going to try again soon - the church part. I also took them to Bible School at Lakeview, Kelleytown, and West Hartsville, besides them going to St. Luke.

Matthew and Andrew talk about you a lot and miss you and Caroline. So do Ben and Glenn. Glenn has a comb that you gave him while you were at my house and he is ever so particular with it. They also remember things that you have told them and will say something like, "NaNa said..." Matthew will ask me, "Do you remember the day I talked to Mammy for two hours?" Little Glenn said he has inherited your musical talent that he is going to pursue with the violin. You would be so proud if you could hear him play. He has already been in two programs at school. Matthew wants to take piano lessons. No one yet has the touch that you had when you played. Everyone I listen to is compared to you, and you are still the best.

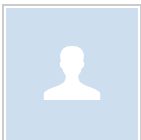

I feel that I lost so much time with you because of Caroline's illness and my continuing medical problems but I know that you wanted me to be with Caroline and didn't mind me being away from you. I still hate that I left and went to Atlanta to have my surgery, even though I HAD to have it done as that took even more time away from me being with you. I will forever cherish our times together through thick and thin...you can guess who ended up thin and who is thick!...see I did get some of that Woodham wit. Dr. Lyons said in his sympathy note that he knew that I was distraught about having to leave you but that you had "released" me to leave you to get the medical care that I needed and that you wanted what was best for me. I wish that I could compose music and literature like you and I believe I would do an entire series on "lost" & "wasted" time. The night time before bed is one of the most difficult times for me because that is when this branch of your three generations - me, Caroline and you - did most of our telephone conversations. Early the morning after you left us, I told Little Glenn and Ben that I was back home now because you had gone to heaven. You two little "hearts" were broken. Ben went to school and did not miss a day because he said he knew his

*NaNa and his Cissy would not want him to miss school. Little Glenn stayed home one day with me...sometimes I think that he feels like he has to protect and help me through things since Caroline is gone. He says he's my oldest now. That night when I went into their room to pray and help them get to sleep, Little Glenn asked me "Can we call NaNa?" My heart sank and I told him that they didn't have phones in Heaven. I don't know if you remember but we called you at bedtime, even in the hospital and from Atlanta and Debby would put the speakerphone on so they could say goodnight. I miss you so much Moma. I love you forever! Kiss Caroline and everybody else like MeMa, Granddaddy Sullivan, Aunt Judy, Aunt Lottie, Uncle Edward and please give Bunkin, Aunt Sister and Daddy Gus a special hug and kiss from me.

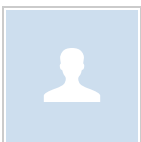
