



Mrs. Mary Ethel Huggins Smith

November 11, 1918 - January 7, 2016

Memorial services for Mary Ethel Huggins Smith, 97, of Hartsville, SC will be held Saturday, January 9, 2016 at 1:00 p.m. at the First Church of God of the Reformation at 1823 Kelleytown Road, Hartsville, SC. The Reverend Bizand Gainey, Reverend John Payne, and Reverend John Kakish will officiate and Brown Pennington Atkins Funeral Home is serving the family. Mrs. Smith died Thursday, January 7, 2016. Born in Bishopville, SC, the twelfth of thirteen children, she was the daughter of the late John Wiley Huggins and Mary M. Colvin Huggins. She was a graduate of Ashwood-Central High School, married Thomas Bruce Smith of Bishopville in 1936 and had five children. She and her husband founded BoSmith Furniture Company of Hartsville and she worked with her husband in the business until his death in 2001. She continued to work for BoSmith Furniture thereafter until 2010.

Mrs. Smith was a devout Christian and instrumental in organizing the First Church of God of the Reformation of Hartsville on Kelleytown Road where she worshipped for over sixty-seven years. She was active in the State Church of God Association and represented the South Carolina Ministry at the national conventions for over thirty years. Mrs. Smith was predeceased in death by her husband (2001) and her oldest son, Thomas Bruce Smith, Jr. (2015).

Surviving are four of her five children; daughters Lynn Gainey (Howard) of

Hartsville, SC, Sara Odom (Phillip) of Hartsville, SC, and Argent Jacobs (Dillard) of Columbia, SC, son Karl H. Smith (JoAnn) of Hartsville, SC and her oldest son's wife, Dorothy Tedder Smith, of Oates, SC. Her grandchildren are Mary Keels (Chris) of Greenville, SC, Rev.
