Minnie "Mickey" B. Spivey, age 69, of Ankeny, Iowa, passed away peacefully at her home, surrounded by family, on March 26, 2022. She earned a Bachelor of Science in Medical Technology with a 4.0 GPA in the summer of 1994. She worked at Iowa Methodist Medical Center as a Medical Technologist in the Blood Bank Lab, where she retired in 2016.
