Monnie was born November 9, 1944, in Hartsville, SC, along with her twin sister, Jonnie. She was the daughter of John Hamilton (Buck) Thomas and Claudine Gardner Thomas. Monnie graduated from Hartsville High School with the class of '63. Years later, she graduated from Kentucky Wesleyan College in Owensboro, KY and then received her Master's in Library & Information Science from Indiana University in Bloomington, Indiana. She was a Library Media Specialist for many years in schools where they lived while travelling around with Richard's job. She loved books and her students.
