

Mr. Nelson Kinsey Gibson

October 1, 1946 - July 18, 2013

Nelson Kinsey Gibson died Thursday, July 18, 2013. Born in Hartsville, SC, he was a son of the late Willie S. and Virginia Carey Gibson. Nelson was a 1964 graduate of Hartsville High School where he played on the baseball team for Coach Ray Petty. He was awarded the MVP award his senior year. In 1968, he graduated from Clemson University with a degree in Geology. He was a walk-on outfielder for Clemson. He played for Coach Bill Wilhelm in the outfield and as a relief pitcher and was named MVP in 1968. Upon his graduation, he was drafted by the Seattle Pilots which later became the Milwaukee Brewers. His minor league career was interrupted by the Vietnam War where he served in the U. S. Army from 1970-1971. He began teaching history at Calhoun Falls High School in 1972 and coached the baseball team for many years. He became assistant principal and then served as principal until his retirement.

Surviving are his son, Kinsey Gibson of Asheville, NC; daughters, Anna Nikol Lindler of Jacksonville, FL, Alexandra Gibson of Abbeville, SC; sisters, Beth Byerly of Hartsville, SC, Juanita Benes of Sylacauga, AL; three grandchildren. The family thanks Morningside Assisted Living and Agape Hospice of Hartsville for their loving care. 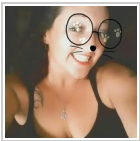

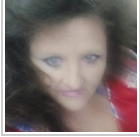

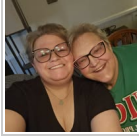
