Norma Jean Johnson King, age 90, passed away Sunday, August 11, 2024, at her and her daughter's home following a long battle with Alzheimer's disease.

Mrs. King was born in Hartsville, the daughter of the late Clayton Leroy Johnson, Sr. and the late Nettie Allen Johnson. She was a member of West Hartsville Baptist Church and, prior to retirement, was a school teacher in Kentucky and South Carolina.
