Growing up at the beach fostered her lifelong love of the ocean. Pam was a member of Bethlehem United Methodist Church in Bishopville. She loved the Lord and was passionate about reading her Bible. She was a prayer warrior and intercessor for her family and many others. She was an incredible mother, grandmother, and friend who will be missed by all who had the pleasure of knowing her.
