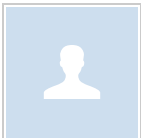


“ Dear Ruth, Sharon and Phil (and to all who love Patty):

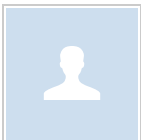

“ Our Pattie Cooke

Pattie was a kind, gentle woman who loved her family, who loved music, and who loved all animals, especially her dog Lilly. She also was very smart, and very insightful about herself and about the human condition. She had a “tender heart” and was sensitive and caring about other people’s hurts.

Pattie was beautiful and feminine, and loved pretty colors like pink and purple and lavender. She loved to dress in those colors, in soft fabrics, and to wear her hair long. It appealed to her romantic side. One of her heroes was the singer Stevie Nicks, because Pattie related to the life experiences that Stevie had, as well as loving the music that she sang. Pattie tried out with a band in Chapel Hill, sang her heart out, and hoped to have a career like Stevie’s some day. It appealed to her dramatic side.

In one of the Stevie Nicks’ songs she sings ” Well I’ve run through rainbows and castles of candy

I cried a river of tears from the pain

I try to dance with what life has to hand me

My partner’s been pleasure...my partner’s been pain

There are days when I swear I could fly like an eagle

And dark desperate hours that nobody sees

My arms stretched triumphant on top of the mountain

My head in my hands...down on my knees”

Pattie struggled during her whole adult life with depression, but she faced that daily struggle with strength and with hope that she could conquer it. It did not define who she was. She had lots of beautiful days, as well as lots of dark days.

She had such big beautiful blue eyes, and such a sweet smile. She could be fierce and tough, too, when she wanted to be. Once in Chapel Hill she confronted a man who was harassing her sister when she bumped into him at the grocery store. She told him that he better leave her sister alone or he would have to answer to her! She was very devoted to her sister, Sharon.

Another of her favorite singers, Sheryl Crowe, sings an old Carter family song that Pattie sent her father last October, and told him she

loved it. It was written during the great depression of the 1930s and it's called "No Depression in Heaven." The second verse is:

*I'm going where there's no depression,
To the lovely land that's free from care
I'll leave this world of toil and trouble,
My home's in Heaven, I'm going there.*

Her family respected her determination and spirit, and loved her dearly. We feel that Stevie and Sheryl, had they known her, would have loved her as much as we do.

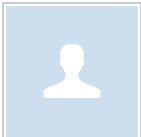
