



Mr. Patrick Lee Johnson

September 2, 1954 - November 23, 2024

Patrick Lee Johnson, 70, of Spring Hill, Florida, passed away quietly on November 23, 2024. Mr. Johnson was born in Hartsville, South Carolina, on September 2, 1954. He was the son of the late Arthur Lee Johnson and Ellen Watts Johnson.

Mr. Johnson was a 1972 graduate of Hartsville High School. He served as a Medic in the United States Navy and was stationed at Naval Station Pearl Harbor in Hawaii. Following his Honorable Discharge from the Navy, he attended Spartan College of Aeronautics and Technology. He graduated in 1981. He worked in the field of nuclear power plants and was an Engineer of Quality and Safety Control at Robert Emmett Ginna Nuclear Plant, Florida Power and Light, and the Tennessee Valley Authority.

His passions were football and fishing. He loved the University of South Carolina Gamecocks. He was preparing a tailgate lunch for the South Carolina game on the day he passed away. He often said he was happiest when he was in his boat fishing the Florida waters.

Mr. Johnson is survived by his beloved wife of forty years, Pamela Duffy Johnson; twin sons, Bryan Patrick Johnson and Paul Whitfield Johnson of Hartsville, South Carolina; a daughter, Rachel Ellen Johnson of Spring Hill, Florida; a granddaughter, Abrianna Marie DiRosa-Johnson of Long Beach,

California; and sisters, Dr. Victoria Killen (Jim) of York South Carolina and Deborah Ellen Johnson of Florence, South Carolina.

A memorial service to honor his life will be held on Wednesday, December 11, 2024, at 1:00 at the Florida National Cemetery in Bushnell, Florida.
