It is with deep sorrow that the Stokes family announces the death of Mr. Paul Maurice Stokes, Jr., 81.

Mr. Stokes entered into rest on Tuesday, January 23, 2024. The Directors of Brown-Pennington-Atkins Funeral Home & Crematory are caring for the family.
