Dr. Moyd died Saturday, March 17, 2012. Born in Asheville, NC and grew up in Ninety Six, SC, he was a son of the late Daniel Livingston and Marie Moyd. He was a wonderful physician and surgeon who practiced medicine for 50 years. He was a graduate of Clemson University, the Medical University of South Carolina and completed his residency at the Medical College of Virginia. He enjoyed hunting, fishing, wildlife and woodworking, but what he cherished most was his family.

Surviving are his wife of 55 years, Deryl "Dee"; four sons, Ken (Diane), David (Lee), Alan (Fran), John (Suzy); brother, Dan (Gertha); 12 grandchildren.
