



Rev. Bill Johnson

Funeral services for Rev. Bill Johnson, 80, will be held at 3:00 p.m. Friday, December 7, 2007 at the Clyde Church of God. The Rev. Don Childers and the Rev. M. Thomas Propes will officiate with burial in the church cemetery directed by Brown-Pennington-Atkins Funeral Home. Mr. Johnson died Tuesday, December 4, 2007. Born in Darlington Co., SC, he was a son of the late Boyd and Essie Henderson Johnson. He was a member of Clyde Church of God and retired from active pastoral ministry in 1991. He was an Ordained Bishop with the Church of God (Cleveland, TN) and pastored South Carolina congregations in Johnsonville, Jefferson, the Lydia Mill Church of God in Clinton, Donalds, Myrtle Beach, Hamer, Conway, McColl and the Clyde Church of God in Hartsville. He founded and pastored the Bethune Church of God. He served the Church of God in South Carolina on the Evangelism and Home Missions Board and the Examining Board.

Surviving are his wife, Florence McLaughlin Johnson of Hartsville, SC; sister, Mary Lee Tidwell of Hartsville, SC; grandsons (spouse), Rev. Chris (Karen) Johnson of Cordova, SC, Boyd Ivan Johnson of Greenville, SC; granddaughter, Buffy Johnson of Hartsville, SC; great-grandson, Dakota Flowers of Hartsville, SC; daughter-in-law, Vivian Langley Johnson of Hartsville, SC. sisters, Ella Mae Munn, Vadie Lee Blackwell.

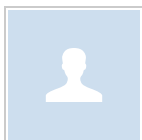
