



Mr. Richard "Dick" Fagan

November 8, 1925 - November 22, 2011

Funeral services for Richard Malcolm "Dick" Fagan, 86, will be held at 3:00 p.m. Friday, November 25, 2011 at St. Luke United Methodist Church. The Rev. Phil Thrailkill will officiate with burial in Magnolia Cemetery directed by Brown-Pennington-Atkins Funeral Home. The family will receive friends Thursday, November 24, 2011 from 5-7 p.m. at the Fagan residence, 297 Warner Dr., Hartsville, SC 29550. Mr. Fagan, widower of Ann Quinn Fagan, died Tuesday, November 22, 2011. Born in Hartsville, SC, he was a son of the late James Vernon and Emma Bethune Fagan. He was a charter member of St. Luke United Methodist Church. He served in the U. S. Navy during World War II. In high school he lettered in football, basketball, baseball and track and was the South Carolina MVP in the Shrine Bowl. He played football at the University of South Carolina, lettering in 1947, 1948 and 1949. He was owner and operator of Hartsville Furniture for 43 years and was the Southern Home Furnishings 1990 Retailer of the Year. He was a member of the Kiwanis, past president of the Jaycees, past president of the Red Fox Club and the first president of the Hartsville Gamecock Club.

Surviving are his son and daughter-in-law, Steve and Lisa King Fagan of Hartsville, SC; the love of his life, his granddaughter, SaraAnn King Fagan. He was preceded in death by his sister, Margaret Jane Hirst. The family would
