It is with deep sorrow that the Davis family announces the death of their beloved father, Mr. Ricky Davis, 70.

Mr. Davis entered into rest on Friday, January 19, 2024. The Directors of Brown-Pennington-Atkins Funeral Home & Crematory are caring for the family.
