Mr. Barber died Friday, March 11, 2011. Born in Atlanta, GA, he was a son of the late Donald Lee and Wilda Jean Bodkin Barber. Robert was a graduate of Fort Johnson High School in Charleston and spent 2 years at Trident Tech in Charleston. He married Kimberly Clark on August 27, 1988. They had been married 22 years at the time of his death. He was a member of the Masonic Lodge in Charleston. An avid race enthusiast, Robert drove racecars at Summerville Speedway. He was currently the General Manager at Applebee's in Hartsville and kept the grounds and cemetery at Wesley Chapel United Methodist Church in Lydia in immaculate condition. 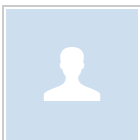
