He was a graduate of Pulaski Senior High School in New Britain, CT, Class of 1971, and he graduated from Central Connecticut State University with his Bachelor of Science in 1975.

Bob had a long prosperous career in Software development and IT. After working for several years for the state of Connecticut, he enrolled in an immersive course in computer software.

Bob was then hired by Policy Management Systems Corporation, based in Columbia, SC, in 1981, where he became part of the original team that created and led PMSC's expansion into international territory, focused on northern and southern Europe. Additional work included IT development with Duck Creek and Mindtree, as well as private consulting.

Bob's talents were many: an accomplished golfer, photographer, a beloved father, and a friend who loved to entertain.

He enjoyed traveling the world with work, family, and friends and making many wonderful memories along the way. He also enjoyed taking trips to the beach and golf trips with his best friends and was an active member of St. Mary the Virgin Mother Roman Catholic Church and the Hartsville Country Club.

He is survived by his loving daughter, Ansley Engwall of Columbia, SC; sister, Debbie Kowalski of New Britain, CT; fiancée, Kyle Anne Barnett of Hartsville, SC.
