



## Rock Truett

Funeral services for T. E. "Rock" Truett, Jr., 78, will be held at 2:00 p.m. Monday, February 7, 2005 at First Presbyterian Church. The Rev. Mr. Truett died Friday, February 4, 2005. Born in Florence Co., SC, he was a son of the late T. E. Truett, Sr. and the late Mildred Graham Truett Hughes. Following his 1944 graduation from Hartsville High School, he entered the Army. He completed basic training in Florida, was stationed in Germany and France for two years and discharged as a sergeant. Upon his return to the states he attended Wake Forest University and was graduated from Coker College in 1951 with a BS in biology. He was employed by the Coker Pedigreed Seed Company in Hartsville, International Minerals and Chemical Company as plant manager and retired as an employee of the State of South Carolina.

Mr. Truett was a member of First Presbyterian Church where he sang in the choir for many years. He was a member of the Hartsville Masonic Lodge #173 and a lifetime member of the VFW.
