It is with deep sorrow that the McBride family announces the death of Mr. Roger Bruce McBride, 58.

Mr. McBride entered into rest on Tuesday, April 18, 2023. The Directors of Brown-Pennington-Atkins Funeral Home & Crematory are caring for the family.

A private family memorial service to honor his life will be held in the First Presbyterian Church Prayer Garden, with The Rev. Ashley Cheek officiating. The family will receive friends from 5:00 until 7:00 pm on Tuesday, April 25, 2023, at the funeral home.
