Funeral services for Rose Carolyn Brannan Roseveare will be held at 3:00 p.m. Sunday, May 18 at the First Presbyterian Church of Hartsville, SC. The Rev. Dr. Dan Sansbury will officiate with a private burial in Magnolia Cemetery directed by Brown-Pennington-Atkins Funeral Home. The family will receive friends Saturday from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. at the funeral home.

Mrs. Roseveare died Friday, May 16, 2014. Born in Johnson County, NC, she was a daughter of the late Jesse Morris and Zilphia Barham Brannan. She was married for fifty-four wonderful years to her dear, devoted husband, David Arthur Roseveare, and they have resided in Hartsville since 1960.

Rose graduated from Coker College and taught science in Hartsville public schools and Thomas Hart Academy. She continued to pursue her life-long love of books and literacy and served as school librarian at THA, and then as Branch Manager for the Hartsville Memorial Library.

She was a long-time member of the First Presbyterian Church where she served as a Deacon, Christian Education Committee member, and Librarian and Resource Manager.

Rose loved working on her family genealogy, gardening and completing puzzles. Family was always important to her, and she enjoyed her role as grandmother very much. She passes on her passion for reading to her children and grandchildren.
