



Mrs. Ruby Rosine Kirkley

December 20, 1929 - February 7, 2014

Funeral services for Rosine Langston Kirkley, 84, will be held at 2:00 pm Sunday, February 9, 2014 at the First Baptist Church Chapel.

The Rev. Charles Roberts will officiate with a private burial in Magnolia Cemetery. The family will receive friends following the service in the Chapel.

Mrs. Kirkley died Friday, February 7, 2014. Born in Hartsville, SC, she was a daughter of the late Herbert Earl and Ruby Ham Langston.

She was a graduate of the University of South Carolina Nursing School and was employed at Bowen's Clinic, Byerly Hospital and McLeod Regional Medical Center. She was a lifetime member of First Baptist Church, served as a Sunday school teacher, and helped with the Mission Bazaar and VBS. She started her foreign mission ministry in 1996 and served in Romania, Kenya, Honduras, Trinidad, and Nairobi. She was a volunteer for HIM, Free Medical Clinic, Good News Club (Carolina Elementary and W. Hartsville Elementary) and made weekly visits to Morningside and shut-ins.

Surviving are her daughter, Teresa (Larry) Gainey of Hartsville, SC; sons, Mike (Dangie) Kirkley of Hartsville, SC, Mark (Donna) Kirkley of Winter Garden, FL; sister, Jean Brown of Hartsville, SC; grandchildren, Tammy (Cliff) Huckabee, Lori (Puddin) Shaw, Michael (Joseph) Kelly, Erin (Garrit) Hawk, Brandi (Luke) Czerwinski, Kyle Kirkley and Kevin Kirkley; fifteen great-grandchildren; one great-great-grandchild.
