



Mrs. Ruby Scurry Northcutt

September 14, 1937 - January 4, 2015

Funeral services for Ruby Scurry Northcutt, 77, will be held at 2 p.m. on Wednesday, Jan. 7, at Greater Heights Baptist Church. The Rev. 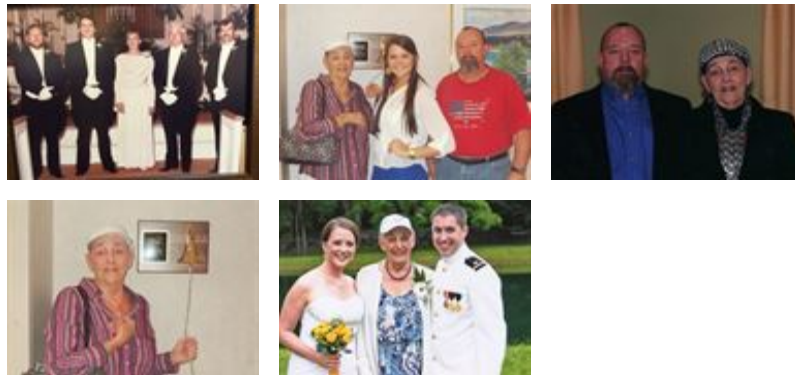
