June 21, 1950 - June 10, 2025

It is with deep sorrow that the Laughter family announces the death of their beloved father, Mr. Sidney George "Sid" Laughter, 74.

Mr. Laughter entered into rest on Tuesday, June 10, 2025, in Youngsville, NC, surrounded by his loving family after a courageous nine-month battle with cancer. The Directors of Brown-Pennington-Atkins Funeral Home & Crematory are caring for the family.

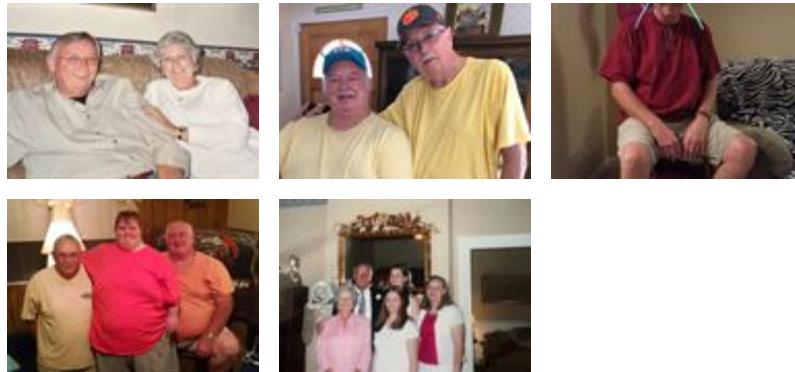

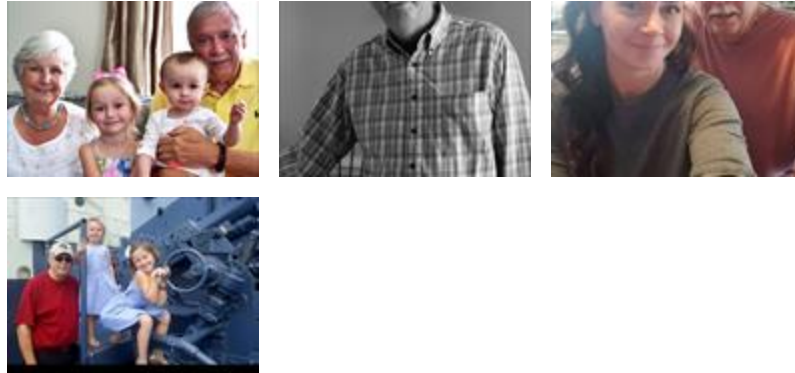
