



Mrs. Sloan Hungerpiller Brittain

November 20, 1921 - May 6, 2016

Memorial service for Sloan Hungerpiller Brittain, 94, will be held at 2:00 pm Saturday, May 7, 2016 at St. Bartholomew's Episcopal Church Prayer Garden. The Rev. Bill Oldland will officiate.

Mrs. Brittain, widow of Deward B. Brittain whom she married in 1943, died Friday, May 6, 2016. Born in Hartsville, SC, she was a daughter of the late John C and Leland Segars Hungerpiller.

Sloan was an alumna of Coker College, Hartsville, and a graduate of the University of South Carolina in 1943, School of Journalism. She was a member of St. Bartholomew's Episcopal Church and a member of the Altar Guild there and at other churches in Rock Hill, Newberry and Salisbury, NC for more than 50 years. She was past chairman and member of the board of directors of Kalmia Gardens of Coker College and past president and volunteer with the Guild of the Jacob Kelley House Museum. She was preceded in death by her brother, Kent Hungerpiller, and sister, Gladys H. Ingram. Surviving are a brother, James E. Hungerpiller of Savannah, GA, and a number of nieces and nephews.
