



Mr. Stephen Joseph Kavanagh

September 26, 1955 - August 19, 2022

A memorial service to honor the life of Mr. Stephen Joseph Kavanagh, 66, will be held at 3:00 p.m. on Wednesday, August 24, 2022, at Society Hill Presbyterian Church with the Rev. Bob Sloan officiating. The Directors of Brown-Pennington-Atkins Funeral Home and Crematory are caring for the family.

Mr. Kavanagh entered into rest on Friday, August 19, 2022. Born in Levittown, NY, he was a son of Steve Kavanagh and the late Catherine Hanley Kavanagh. After moving to South Carolina, Steve faithfully served as an officer with the Darlington Police Department and the Society Hill Police Department for 27 years. He took great pride in his service to the community. Health issues led to an early retirement.

A faithful member of Society Hill Presbyterian Church, Steve found a way to continue serving the community during his retirement. He founded the church's Manna From Heaven meal distribution ministry. At least once a week, Steve would prepare meals and deliver them to shut-ins, elderly, and the needy. He began the ministry with his own money, believing that God would provide if he did the work. The program began with preparing and serving just a few meals, but quickly grew to as many as 50. Steve's faith in God held true and each week there was enough funds to make the meals and enough people to help deliver them. The ministry which Steve began continues to

serve the community. Even with his health problems, Steve would often make his way to the church and help in preparing the meals. Steve's faith in Jesus Christ was strong and he expressed that in so many ways. We are thankful to know that he is now rejoicing in the presence of our Heavenly Father.

In addition to his father, he is survived by his daughter, Stephanie Kavanagh Stewart (Greg) of Hartsville, SC; sisters, Maureen Domanico (Sol) of Island Park, NY, Kathleen Kavanagh of Hartsville, SC; brothers, Kevin Kavanagh (Donna) of Hartsville, SC, Billy Kavanagh (Pat) of Valley Stream, NY, Timmy Kavanagh (Laura) of Levittown, NY; numerous nieces and nephews.

In addition to his mother, he was preceded in death by a nephew, Christopher Kavanagh.

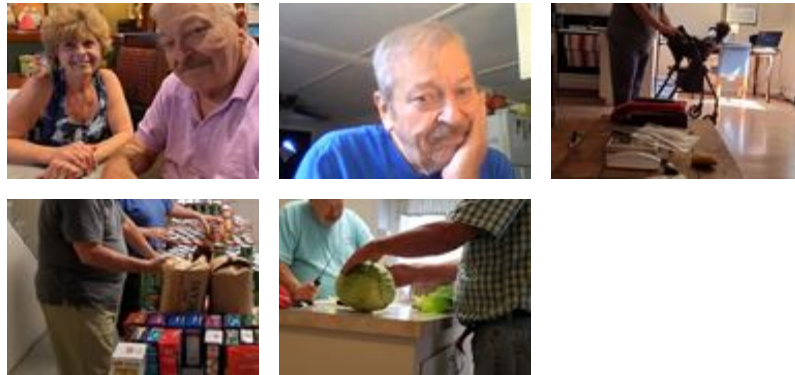
