It is with deep sorrow that the Ham family announces the death of Mr. Thomas Edison Ham, 73. Mr. Ham entered into rest on Thursday, January 20, 2022.

A graveside funeral service to honor his life will be held at 11 o'clock on Monday, January 24, 2022, in Mt. Elon Baptist Church Cemetery, with The Rev. Billy Jordan and the Rev. Rob Brazell officiating. The family will receive friends in the Fellowship Hall immediately following the service.
