Todd A. Musick passed away on Monday, October 3, 2016 at home after a valiant battle with cancer. Born in Philadelphia, PA on April 12, 1956, he was the son of Walter and Irene "Sandy" Musick. Todd attended high school in Greensboro, NC and received a degree in Textile Management from NC State, in 1983.

The game of rugby was a lifelong passion of Todd's. He played with the Caper Fear Rugby Club and the Virginia Cardinals. He was an inspiring coach, mentor, and role model for the UNCW Clamdiggers.
