She enjoyed spending time with her grandson, Brandon, son-in-law, Wes, and daughter, Kathy, whom looked just like her, loved eating her niece Barbara Gore's cooking, whom she referred to as Martha Stewart, and her greatest love was her grandson, Brandon, whom she adored. She was known as a "double barrel Johnson" to her family. Jenny Mae loved her late husband, Robert Oakley, with all of her heart and soul.

In addition to her parents, Mrs. Oakley was also preceded in death by her husband, Robert Lee Oakley; brother, Rudolph Catoe, and sisters, Claudia Koon, Hazel Boyd, and Grace Hooker.
