

## Mr. Walter Dewey Bell Jr.

Funeral services with full military honors for Mr. Walter Dewey Bell, Jr., 86, who entered into rest on Friday, April 5, 2019, will be held at 2 o'clock on Tuesday, April 9, 2019, in The Chapel of Hancock-Elmore-Hill Funeral Home. He served in Vietnam, earning the Vietnam Service Medal and the Republic of Vietnam Campaign Medal. Walter also gave eight years in the Civil Service at Myrtle Beach Air Force Base as a Fire Protection and Fire Rescue. Walter Bell loved fishing and spending time with his children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren.

He is survived by his wife Carrie Mae Bell; sons, Wayne (Sherry) Bell, Phillip (Crystal) Bell, Glen Bell; daughters, Gina (Marty Skelton) Houck, Teresa (Peanut) Bell; sister, Sadie Truesdale; grandchildren, Wesley P. 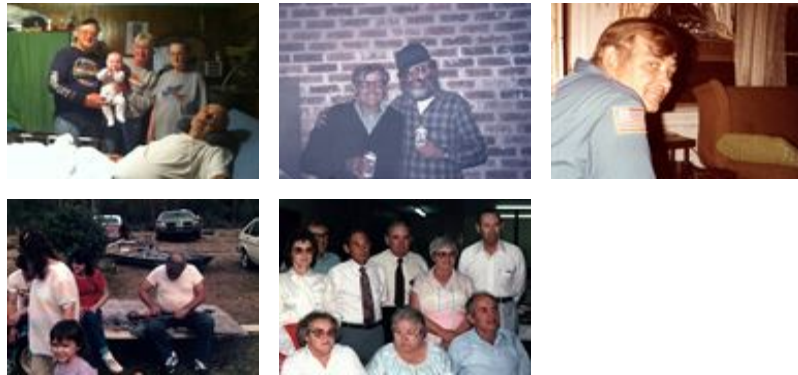
